**DUNLOP BOLTON SPORTS FEDERATION
TENNIS LEAGUE CONSTITUTION**

Name : The Organisation is "Dunlop Bolton Sports Federation Tennis League". It is a non-profit making organisation.

Government: An Administrative Committee elected at the Annual General Meeting (AGM) shall govern the League. All members of the Administrative Committee, ex-officio members of the BSF and a representative from each club can attend any annual meeting.

Policy: The policy of the League shall be that agreed upon by the representatives at the AGM.

Objective: To promote the game of Tennis.

Administrative Committee: The Administrative Committee shall consist of President, Vice-President, Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Treasurer, General Secretary, Match Secretary (Mixed League), Match Secretary (Men's League), Match Secretary (Ladies' League), Match Secretary (Junior League), Match Secretary (Winter League), Match Secretary (Over 50s League), Registration Secretary, Tournament Secretary, Tournament Referee, Trophy Secretary, Tennis Lancashire Representative, Sponsorship Co-ordinator, ex-officio members of the Executive Committee and nine elected representatives, who together with the Match Secretaries form the League Working Committee. The Committee shall have the authority to co-opt. All Committee members and associates are volunteers and receive no remuneration for their services during the year.

Elections: The President, who need not be a member of the Tennis League, shall be nominated by the Administrative Committee and elected at the AGM for a period of 3 years, but shall be eligible for re-election. The President is an ex-officio member of all committees and in the event of him/her being present at the AGM, shall receive an invitation to chair the meeting. The AGM may also elect Vice-Presidents who shall hold office for an indefinite period.

Election of all other officers and Committee members takes place at the AGM.

Quorum: A committee meeting shall be quorate when seven members are present.

Duties of the Administrative Committee: The Committee shall:

- (a) consider all matters referred to it and take expedient action.
- (b) be responsible for the administration of the League, for conforming to BSF Fundamental Rules and for submitting an Annual Report and League Account to the AGM with any such further information that may be required.

Duties of the Chairman: The Chairman shall preside over the AGMs of the League when the President is absent or due for re-election, with powers to summon special meetings of the Committees through the Secretary.

Duties of the Vice-Chairman: The Vice-Chairman shall deputise in the absence of the Chairman. In the absence of both, the members present will elect the Chairman.

Duties of the Secretary: The Secretary shall:

- (a) with the Chairman, be responsible for calling all meetings, preparing minutes and for maintaining the records of the League.
- (b) submit to the Committees, all matters of league business.
- (c) be responsible for all correspondence received and sent;
- (d) be provided with a deputy on request.

Duties of the Treasurer: The Treasurer shall:

- (a) collect all members' subscriptions, fees and fines etc. and be responsible for all League monies;
- (b) pay all reasonable expenses incurred by the League.
- (c) prepare annually, an income and expenditure account made up to 30th November or such other date as shall from time to time be decided;
- (d) submit to the Committee meetings, statements of funds, balances and where required, explain any variations.

Duties of the Match Secretaries: The Match Secretaries are delegated by the Administrative Committee to make such decisions as are needed, if necessary, in consultation with relevant parties and their respective Working Committees, to ensure the efficient day-to-day running of their respective leagues. They are to ensure that teams abide by the rules and make such adjustments to published results as necessary, where the rules appear to have been breached.

Subscriptions and Finance: The funds of the League are under the control of the Administrative Committee and deposited in a bank/building society, approved by the Committee, in the name of the League. The Treasurer will sign all cheques and drafts and the Chair or Secretary will countersign.

Standing orders for meetings:

- (a) There will be no discussion on the minutes except as to accuracy. Rescinding of resolutions cannot take place except by a proposal at a subsequent meeting with a two-thirds majority.
- (b) All motions must be proposed and seconded before a debate takes place.
- (c) The following motions may be proposed and seconded without notice and the question put: (i) to suspend the meeting, (ii) to adjourn the meeting, (iii) to proceed to next business, (iv) that the vote takes place. Such motions require a two-thirds majority in favour.
- (d) Items for inclusion on the agenda for Committee meetings must be with the Secretary 48 hours before the meeting.
- (e) Any Other Business at Committee meetings can only include urgent items.
- (f) Each member shall have one vote. The Chairman only has the casting vote in the event of a tie.
- (g) Voting shall be on a show of hands.

(h) At the AGM, which will be held in December, (i) each Club shall have one vote per league played in on changes to the rules provided they are represented by a separate person at the AGM and the club was represented at the Notice of Motion Meeting (NOM) in November, and (ii) each Club and League Officer shall have one vote on other matters. No person can have two votes in different capacities.

Membership:

- (a) All applications for League Membership shall be subject to acceptance at the AGM.
- (b) A team shall be deemed to be a member of the League on receipt of all required subscriptions, fees etc. by the League Treasurer.

Protests and appeals: All protests must be in writing and sent to the League Secretary or relevant Match Secretary not later than seven days after the match. If an answer cannot be provided a copy of the protest will be sent to the Secretary of the club which is the subject of the protest for a response upon which a decision can be made. Any decision of the Committee or a Match Secretary acting on behalf of the Committee is subject to appeal which must be received in writing email from the Club Secretary within seven days of the decision and accompanied by a fee of £20 (refundable only if the protest is upheld). On appeal, a personal hearing can take place. If confirmation of the original decision takes place then Members have a further right of appeal to the BSF Executive Committee if there is evidence of a breach of the Tennis League Rules.

Should any member of the Committee be interested or concerned in any dispute, claim or protest, he or she shall not remain in the room whilst such a case is being decided.

TENNIS LEAGUE RULES (Updated 2022)

BSF Fundamental Rules

Competitors shall be amateurs. For the purposes of these rules, an amateur is one who does not receive remuneration or consideration of any kind directly or indirectly, whilst representing their club in a Federation Competition.

All competitors shall register with each League. Each league will collect the full name of the competitor and any other details required for the operational needs of the League. It must be understood that each competitor agrees to conform to the rules of the League and understands the potential hazards and agrees that the League is not liable for any accident, injury or loss. Forms shall be countersigned by the Club Chairman, Secretary or Treasurer. An email or other electronic registration from such an official shall carry the same standing as a written form. It is understood that Club Officials will have enquired into the qualifications of such competitor and that he or she is duly qualified to compete in accordance with the rules of the Federation and League.

The League must have suitable rules in place that clearly define any player's eligibility for any particular match. Registered players wishing to transfer to another Club must declare their previous Club has been advised. Such transfers must be approved by the League Committee.

Government

1. A Guarantee Fee per team must be submitted with the Team Entry Form to the League Secretary by 31st January in any season. The amount to be decided annually at the General Meeting. Providing funds allow it, a rebate shall be made to each team at the end of each season providing that the team has adhered to all the rules. The Committee shall decide the amount of the rebate when the season's final figures are available. The rebate shall not exceed 30% and will be deducted from the following year's fees.

2. The Administrative Committee shall have power to divide the competitions into divisions or sections when deemed advisable. A system of promotion and relegation shall operate. Normally two teams will receive promotion and two will undergo relegation. Champions of Divisions will receive promotion and the bottom team will undergo relegation. In the Junior League, teams can request relegation.

3. Any club joining the League, as a new member, shall go into a division decided by the Administrative Committee.

4. Any club wishing to give Notice of Motion must do so in writing to the General Secretary by 30th September. The NOM will be called at least one month prior to the AGM.

5. The LTA rulebook governs all matches of the league.

6. Each club shall have an LTA rulebook.

7. Each club will receive copies of the official rules. A player's registration fees will include the cost of a fixture book.

8 All fixture dates shall be arranged by the Administrative Committee.

9. Matches

- (i) must be as per the fixtures. The postponement of any match cannot take place without the authorisation of the Administrative Committee.
- (ii) are to be played at the home team's nominated courts, and the venue may not be re-arranged without the prior agreement of the Administrative Committee.

10. Any matter not provided for in these rules shall be dealt with by the Administrative Committee as it deems fit. It shall have the power to interpret any of these rules or any alterations or additions thereto, and give rulings on any matter on which the rules are silent. It shall also have the right to impose a fine, or any other such penalty it deems fit, for the breaking of any rule or if a protest is upheld. Any decision is subject to appeal and a personal hearing.

11. Entries for all teams must be in the hands of the League Secretary seven days after the AGM or as otherwise agreed at the AGM. Fine for late submission - £20.00. Clubs who withdraw teams before or during the season will lose their guarantee fee and any results obtained will be expunged from the record.

12. Any Club not represented at the Notice of Motion meeting shall have no vote at the AGM on the one vote per club basis.

13. Any club not represented at the NOM or the AGM will receive a £10 fine for each absence.

14. All debts incurred during the playing season must be paid by the AGM, otherwise the club will not be allowed to enter any teams in the subsequent season.

Trophies

1. The League shall only be responsible for six mementoes to the winners and runners up of the Cecil Cup, and to the champions and runners up of each division in the senior competitions and four in the junior competition.

2. All extra trophies per team shall be applied for, and permission being granted, the cost shall be defrayed by the club concerned.

3. No team or individual shall receive any trophies

(a) until all fees have been paid by the club,

(b) if it is not represented at the Presentation Dance.

4. The Administrative Committee shall have power to withhold the trophies for any team at its discretion.

5. The Administrative Committee shall choose mementoes for the champions and runners-up.

6. All clubs are responsible for all trophies presented to their teams and their members. They must all be returned to the Trophy Secretary by 19th July. Clubs will be fined £20 by that date for each missing trophy. Open winners, not attached to a club, must hand trophies back after any photographs have been taken.

8. The Committee reserve the right to make a cleaning charge of £5 per trophy for each one not returned in a clean condition.

Registration of Players and Eligibility

(1) All player registrations are subject to the approval of the Management Committee. Following the initial group registrations of players, any additional player will be automatically registered when they play their first match provided that the name and address of the player is in the hands of the Registration Secretary within 14 days of their appearance. Otherwise, their sets will be forfeited.

The name and address is held on a password protected database and is used to uniquely identify the player and if needed for any written correspondence. It is destroyed when the player, club or the BSF Tennis Committee cancel the registration.

The name together with the name of the club is used on public player registration lists, published online match cards and press reports. Online match cards are destroyed after three years.

Player's statutory rights are not affected. Published names can be replaced if you request that from the BSF Tennis League Committee.

2) (i) A player becomes committed to a match once he/she has played his/her first point and this would count as an appearance for eligibility purposes providing their scores are entered on the score card.

(ii) A player becomes committed to a club in any one competition once he/she has played his /her first point.

(3) During the season, all players are deemed to be ranked to the highest team for which they have played for on two occasions. They may play in that team or one team down. Should they play for a higher team on two occasions, they are automatically re-ranked to that team. After four completed matches, three men in the men's, three ladies in the ladies, three players in the mixed and one boy plus one girl in the junior competitions must be nominated as permanent members of the 'A' team below which they cannot play. They would have been expected to represent the team in at least two of the first four league matches. If a club has two teams in Division 1 the above numbers should be increased by one.

(4) A player may be re-ranked for a lower team but will not be eligible to play for that team until 6 days after the receipt of the application to allow for Committee consultation and the Registration Secretary notifies them.

(5) Player registration closes on July 31st.

(6) In order to field a team **in a league match**, (cups excluded), the lowest team of any club in the bottom two divisions may loan registered players from another club with the approval of the loaning club.

Loaned players must not have played in that division or higher for their own club that season. However, a team in the bottom division may use players from any club in that division whether they have played or not. Loaned players should be of no higher standard than players of the team they are loaned to.

A loaned player must be declared as such on the match card and sets scored as normal.

See Rule (i) re playing unregistered/ineligible players in order to field a full team.

7. (a) In multi-team clubs, players should be selected in order of ability. Lower ranked players shall not play above higher ranked players. If it appears that a lower team has been artificially strengthened, the Administrative Committee may score sets in the lower team's match 6-0.

(b) A player in a lower team may play in a higher team but cannot represent two teams in the same fixture week, unless the fixture date has been altered by the Administrative Committee. However, in the Junior League players may play more than once in the same fixture week on 2 occasions during the season.

(c) A player cannot play for a lower team when a higher team does not have a match for any reason if they have played two or more **league** matches for higher teams than the number of league matches played for the lower team.

(d) In the second half of the season a player who has played half or more of their league matches for the higher team cannot play for the lower team if that leaves the higher team weakened or short of players.

(e) In the event of a team being short of players, a scale of fines shall be imposed as follows:

No. of players missing	Men's Mixed & Ladies' Leagues	Junior League
1 or 2	£5	£2.50
3 or 4	£10	
5 or 6	N/A	

When a club's higher team is short of player(s) for a particular match, then points may be deducted from all lower teams, with fixtures on that day, as follows:

First offence - one point; Second offence - two pts; Third Offence - three pts.

When a club's higher team is short of player(s) for a particular match, then points may be deducted from all lower teams, with fixtures on that day, as follows: In the event of a Cup match, the lower team is eliminated.

See also Match Rule 6 (iv) for juniors.

(f) In the last two fixture weeks of Division 1 of the men's, ladies and mixed competitions a player must have played for their team or a lower team in at least three league matches **prior** to the last two fixture weeks in order to play in any of the last two fixture weeks. Full-time students aged 18 or over, living away from home in term time (who must be registered as such before the 1st July), are exempted from this restriction. Any club having more than one team in Division 1 have their second team exempt from this rule.

In Division 1 of the Junior competition, a player must have played for their team or a lower team in at least three league matches **prior** to the last two fixture weeks in order to play in any of the last two fixture weeks.

In all other divisions only players who have played for their club in that competition at least twice **prior** to the last two fixture weeks are eligible to play.

The Match Secretary must be informed in advance of the match of any player that is required for the lowest team who has not played at least twice and confirmation given that they are clearly of no higher standard than the player they are replacing.

(g) Any queries regarding a player's eligibility should be referred to the Match Secretary before the match.

(h) All ineligible players' sets will be recorded conceded 6-0.

(i) In order to field a full team, unregistered or ineligible players may be included providing that they are declared as such and their results conceded 6-0.

MATCH RULES

1. The competing teams in each division shall play home and away matches against each other, and the clubs in each division securing the highest number of points by the end of the season shall receive trophies. The winners shall be entitled to hold the trophies for one year and these trophies shall never become the absolute property of any club.

2. Each club shall provide a minimum of two outdoor match courts. Matches must not be played on indoor courts. *Juniors may play two matches on three courts.*

3. Each club must provide a first aid box for use in case of accident.

4. For BSF League and Cup matches, net adjusters are desirable but not mandatory.

5. (a) The match card shall be filled up before the game is started, the home captain to fill in the names of his players' first, followed by the visiting captain. Both captains shall see and sign the card which must be posted online within 48 hours of the completion of the match by the home team captain. A fine of £10.00 will be imposed for late posting. Clubs failing to enter a player's name will incur a £5 fine.

The home team should retain the card until the end of the season.

(b) The home team captain shall decide the order of play of the home team couples.

6. In the event of a team failing to appear for a match:

(i) the defaulting team shall lose the match by the maximum score.

(ii) the non defaulting team shall be awarded maximum points and its match score shall be based on the average of the defaulting team's match scores for a minimum of half a season's matches.

(iii) a fine of £20 (Juniors £10) will be imposed, which will be increased if the opponents and the Match Secretary are not notified at least 72 hours before the scheduled match.

(iv) The lowest junior team entered shall not incur a fine when failing to turn out or turning out short when 24 hours' notice has been given to the opposition.

(v) Any team that has had three complete no shows will have that team removed from the league and all results expunged.

7. Play shall be continuous without undue delay between sets. Knock-ups in all competitions shall not exceed five minutes. Any unwarranted delay should be agreed and accepted by the non-defaulting team captain. If he thinks the delay unreasonable (over 15 minutes), the match shall continue and the normal procedure of protest shall be applied if the unwarranted delay is the sole reason for the non-completion of the match on the allotted evening. The times of commencement of matches shall be stated on all score cards by the visiting captain. If a late start is made, the reason shall be specified on the card and the defaulting team fined £5.00 (£2.50 juniors). Sets claimed should not be played.

8. Play may continue under floodlights providing both captains are in agreement. No set should commence after 10.30pm.

9. The home team shall be responsible for providing at least three new LTA nominated Dunlop balls per court for each match. For junior matches the balls need not be new but must be of good quality.

CODE OF CONDUCT

1. To avoid confusion, the serving side should call the score between points.

2. Players should enter the score legibly on the match card at the completion of the set.

3. All players must show respect for their opponents and spectators by conducting themselves in a sporting manner. Gratuitous swearing, intimidation or misuse of equipment must not take place. A justified complaint can result in the withdrawal of a player's registration.

MEN'S, MIXED & LADIES' COMPETITION RULES

1. A men's team shall consist of three gents' couples. A mixed team shall consist of three mixed couples and a ladies' team shall consist of three ladies' couples. Each couple shall play one set against each opposing couple. Sets will be won by the first couple to get to six games, providing they have a two-game lead, otherwise at six all in a set a full normal tiebreak will be played to decide a final game.

2. All couples from each team must be involved in one of the first four sets of the match. Should a team's third pair to play be unavailable for the fourth set due to late arrival then the non-defaulting captain has the right to claim the fourth set at that point but not thereafter.

3. All matches must commence not later than 6.30pm on Mondays (men's), Tuesdays (mixed) and Wednesday or Thursday home slot (Ladies). Should any team fail to be ready for play by 6.30pm the non-defaulting captain has the right to claim the last set 6-0 before play commences but not thereafter. If play has not commenced on the second court by 6.45pm, the non-defaulting captain has the right to claim the penultimate set, (or the last set if play has already commenced on the first court) 6-0 at that time, but not thereafter.

If a third court is available for the whole match, play must commence no later than 7.15pm. If a team's third playing pair are unavailable due to late arrival then the non-defaulting captain has the right to claim this set at that point but not thereafter.

4. The points awarded shall be as follows: a match won 2 points; a match abandoned 1 point, unless a team is in a winning position when the result shall stand. (The result shall be determined by the aggregate sets won in the match).

5. Set difference is to count for the purpose of determining the position of each team in the League. In the event of a tie, the higher position will be awarded to the team having won most sets.

6. Should any question arise of courts being unfit for play, the decision shall be left to the opposing captains. If in the opinion of either captain, the courts are unfit for play the match is abandoned. Once a set has commenced, it must be completed unless both captains are in agreement. Players leaving the court without this agreement forfeit the set.

N.B. It is not expected that play shall continue in the rain. Any match not started by 7.15pm due to inclement weather shall be abandoned.

CECIL CHALLENGE CUP RULES IN THE MIXED LEAGUE

The entire control and management of the Competition shall be vested in the BSF Tennis League Administrative Committee. The Competition shall be governed by the rules of the League with the following additions.

1. The cup shall be competed for annually on a handicap basis, and shall never become the absolute property of any club.

2. Entry to this competition is optional and clubs must make application to the League Secretary before the commencement of the League along with the Guarantee fees.

No fines will be levied for the scratching of a team from a cup competition providing that at least 48 hours' notice have been given to the opposition and the Match Secretary. The entry fee agreed at the AGM shall be forwarded direct to the League Treasurer along with the Guarantee fees, etc. If a Club scratches an entered team, then any player who has played 50% or more league matches for that team cannot play in a lower team.

3. The matches shall be arranged by means of a draw, and no team shall receive more than one bye in any one season. The preliminary, 1st and 2nd rounds are played in two sections. The entries shall be placed in rank order by the Committee and then divided into two sections.

4. Dates of matches shall be arranged by the Administrative Committee, and these fixtures shall be played as arranged and must not be deferred for rearrangement of League Matches.

5. (a) All Cecil Cup matches scheduled to be played on Sundays (start time 2pm) may be played on the preceding Thursday (start time 6.30pm) providing the team is indicated by an * in the list of clubs.

(b) If matches are not completed on the dates arranged, due to bad weather or other uncontrollable causes, the two teams shall make their own arrangements to complete their match within eight days.

6. The following shall apply to rounds prior to the final:

(a) Matches shall be played on the courts of the first drawn of each two teams.

(b) The home team shall be responsible for providing at least three new LTA nominated Dunlop balls per court for each match.

7. The following shall apply to the final tie:

(a) The match shall be played on neutral courts arranged by the Administrative Committee and if it is to be played in an evening, only a club which has three available courts shall be used.

(b) The captains shall toss for choice of acting home or visiting captain.

(c) An official of the League not representing one of the two clubs concerned, shall have the sole responsibility at the final to decide whether the conditions are suitable for play to commence and, if necessary, for the match to recommence after any hold-up or an appeal by the captain, providing that the official of the host club agrees that the courts are playable.

(d) Dates for rearrangements of the final shall be arranged by the Administrative Committee.

8. (a) No recognised higher team player is eligible to play in a lower team, but a lower team player can be played as a reserve for a higher team and will not become cup-tied. From and including the quarter finals, only those players who have played for their team or a lower team at least twice in the Mixed League, excluding Cup Matches, shall be eligible to play. If any team has a problem in meeting this requirement it must be referred to the Match Secretary prior to the match.

(b) Any player having made more than half of his/her appearances for one team shall not be eligible to play for a lower team after the preliminary and first round.

CECIL CUP HANDICAPS

The basis for this is as follows:

(a) For teams in different divisions, the lower team will receive a differential (51* less the total number of teams in the Mixed League Competition) plus one game per place which the lower team occupies below the top team.

NB This differential shall be halved if one of the two top teams in one division is playing one of the two bottom teams in the division immediately above them.

(b) For teams in the same division, the handicaps are based on a maximum of 28*.

(c) Handicaps are to be based on up-to-date results prior to each round, except for Preliminary Round matches, which should be based on the final tables for the preceding season, after adjustment for promotion and relegation.

(d) The match shall be determined by the aggregate games scored, after including the handicap. In the event of a drawn match, the receiving team receives half a game in addition to the handicap.

(* Committee re AGM 2021)

JUNIOR COMPETITION RULES

1. A team shall consist of two boys and two girls playing four mixed doubles sets, one boys' doubles set and one girls' doubles set. Sets will be won by the first couple to get six games, providing they have a two-game lead, otherwise the set will be completed after 12 games, with the set being considered a draw when the score stands at 6-6. Gender substitutes are permitted providing Match Rule 6 is respected. Girls may play as boys but only boys under 12 years of age (on 31st August) to play as a girl.

2. Mixed doubles must be played first.

3. All Matches must commence not later than 6.15pm on Friday evenings. Should any team fail to be ready for play by 6.15pm the non-defaulting team has the right to claim the last mixed set 6-0 before play commences but not thereafter. If play has not commenced on the second court by 6.30pm the non-defaulting team captain has the right to claim the penultimate mixed set 6-0 at that time but not thereafter. Knock-ups shall not exceed five minutes.

4. The points awarded shall be as follows:

A match won - three points; a match tied - two points; a match abandoned - one point unless a team is in a winning position, when the result shall stand (if one team has gained six sets they receive two points and their opponents one point), (the result shall be determined by the aggregate sets won in the match).

5. Set difference is to count for the purpose of determining the position of each team in the League. In the event of a tie, the higher position will be awarded to the team having won most sets.

6. Should any question arise of courts being unfit for play, the decision shall be left to the opposing captains. If in the opinion of either captain, the courts are unfit for play by one hour after scheduled start time the match shall be abandoned.

7. All players registering for this competition must be under 18 years on the 31st August of the current year.

8. New players are allowed to register until the end of the season.

HINTS TO SECRETARIES & CAPTAINS

1. Payments to BSF Tennis League should be made by BACs using the bank details provided.
2. Any other monies should be forwarded direct to the League Treasurer (preferably by BACs).
3. Match cards should be posted online within 48 hours by the home team captain to ensure full "press" reports - and avoid fines.
4. Requests for special fixture considerations should be made annually and not later than the date of the AGM.
5. Always inform the Match Secretary by email for abandoned fixtures.

It is a condition of joining the League that participants must agree that the organisers shall not be liable for any accident, injury, loss or damage as a consequence of participation in the League.

Public Liability Insurance

Public liability insurance is taken out for all events organised by the BSF Tennis League.

Clubs are advised to have their own public liability insurance for their own social or other club events or be covered by being affiliated to the LTA.

BOLTON TENNIS TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS AND GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. The Championships will be conducted under the Rules of Tennis and the Rules and Regulations of The Lawn Tennis Association, under the auspices of the Bolton Sports Federation Tennis League.
2. The events are restricted to players who are registered with the Bolton Sports Federation Tennis League. However, the Men's, Women's, Boys and Girls Singles events and Men's, Women's Level and Mixed Doubles events will be Open. The age restricted Doubles are open to past and present players so long as they are, or have been, registered with the League.
 - Junior 14U for year of birth 2006 to 2009, Junior U18 for year of birth 2002 to 2009.
 - Veteran Mixed Doubles - over 45,
 - Veteran Women's and Veteran Men's Doubles over 50 and Senior Mixed Doubles - over 60 on the date entries close.
3. The Draw for all level open events will be seeded unless run as a single round robin.
4. Entries must be made on the LTA Competitions website. Manual entries are not allowed.
5. Competitors cannot enter more than three events, except juniors. No two First Division players may form a pairing in a handicap event and players who play in Mixed or Men's Division 1 may only enter one handicap event. Juniors can enter four events of which two must be Junior events.
6. Play will commence on the first Friday at 5.45pm and continue at 5.45pm each evening excepting Saturday and Sunday when play may commence at 9.00am. Competitors in Singles events, U14 events and those playing in THREE handicap events, must be available for play on the first Friday of the tournament unless agreed in advance by the Referee. All competitors will be advised of the time of their first matches by email, which cannot be changed and thereafter a notice will be displayed each evening for matches to be played the following evening (see Code of Conduct). Competitors should check at the Referee's Table at 6.00pm on the first Friday evening if they have failed to receive any notification of their first match.
7. Each competitor will receive a copy of the programme of events.
8. All senior matches will be the best of three sets. Level events will be tie breaks operating at 6 games all. Handicap events will be short sets (6-5)

with sudden death deuce in sets 1 and 2 and normal deuce in the 3rd set. The receiving pair to decide receiver except mixed events where lady receives if lady is serving and vice versa for men. Junior matches will be best of 3 FAST4 sets with a 7 point tie break at 3 all. If a match is one set the deciding set will be a 10 point tie break. There will only be 1 serve at deuce, receiver to decide which court. A let on service to be played.

9. Three new tennis balls will be provided for each match.
10. All competitors must be prepared to umpire or line judge, if requested, particularly in handicap events and finals.
11. The Committee of Management reserves the right to restrict the events to such numbers as it may think fit. It reserves the right to cancel an event if it considers insufficient entries have been received or canvas additional entries after the closing date. It reserves the right to decide all questions of eligibility, to refuse any entry without assigning a reason and to alter the conditions at its discretion. It reserves the right to adjust handicaps after the first match.
12. Appropriate other venues will be used for the earlier rounds should this be necessary or in the event of inclement weather.
13. In the event of inclement weather, Saturday morning play may be an essential part of the tournament.
14. **Time off should not be expected** (see Rule 6), but a maximum of 2 requests will be considered if submitted to the Tournament Secretary or Referee and whilst every effort will be made to comply, **no guarantee** can be given. (For doubles competitions, the maximum 2 requests are for the pair). Competitors will have the chance to update requests up to the closing date. Competitors in 3 events must be available on at least one of the first 3 days.

CODE OF CONDUCT

1. It is the sole responsibility of EVERY COMPETITOR to report to the Referees at the control table immediately on arrival each day and it shall be solely the competitor's responsibility to be ready for play when his/her match is called. Competitors intending to default shall advise the referee of their intention and shall concede if they get a match point. Failure to do this will result in non-acceptance of future entries. The LTA Code of Conduct will apply for late withdrawals and rule breaches.
2. Any competitor not ready to play within 15 minutes of being called is liable to be defaulted.
3. No competitor may leave the ground without first having ascertained from the Referees or control table when he or she is next required to play. Failure to do this will result in default.
4. Competitors should wear recognised tennis wear. Tracksuits should normally be removed before play commences.

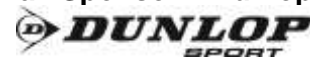

Development of the League over 100 years

The League started with just 8 Clubs in 1922. The Mixed League was the only competition at the start with 6 men and 4 Ladies' playing 2 men's doubles sets, 2 mixed doubles sets and 1 Ladies' doubles set. A men's only league and a junior league have been added since the Second World War. The men's matches consisting of 3 men's pairs playing one set against each of the opponents 3 pairs. The mixed league adopted the same format in 2021 along with the creation of a Ladies' league. The requirement to complete mixed matches on other days if it cannot be finished on the night has been removed to allow the slot for the Ladies' league.

There has been a considerable expansion of the league from the initial 8 clubs. There are now 26 clubs in the league with many putting multiple teams in the leagues. Clubs from outside Bolton now play in the Bolton League with the extremes being Chorley, Bury, Salford and Leigh. The major increase took place during the period when Raymond Marks was the League Chairman. Ray chaired the league for over 30 years and as well as seeing an expansion of the league introduced The Bolton Tournament which is run under the Tennis League banner and will this year be played for the 39th time. The Tournament replaced the previous Bolton Charity Tournament in 1935. Fred Perry and Dan Maskell were patrons in the 1950s.

After the number of teams playing peaked in the late 1990s and early 2000s there was a gradual decline in team entries and the number of Men's leagues reduced to 7 to 9 and the Mixed league from 6 to 5 and the Junior league from 4 to 3. This trend has just started to reverse and with interest in the sport due to Covid restrictions on other sports team numbers are again increasing.

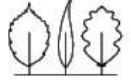
